- 1 - What is the problem you are trying to solve?** To ensure effective approach to community preventative activity which will have maximum impact on improving wellbeing, support independent living, strengthen community resilience and reduce the need for statutory interventions.
- 2 - What long term outcome/change are you hoping to achieve?** For community based provision in Carmarthenshire to assist in making the shift from a reactive model, moving away from a culture of ongoing crisis management that focuses on a small number of people with the greatest needs, to one that addresses the whole population, with a wide range of preventative support at all levels.
- 3 - Who is your key audience?** Older People, physical disabilities and sensory impairment.
- 4 - How will you reach them?** IAA 'single point of contact', network of community connectors and third sector groups.
- 5 - What resources are available to support?** Funding from ICF if approved, Cluster funding that funds the Social Prescribers & Transformation Funding Action Priority 1 and 4. Core Funding from both Health & Social Care & ICF Dementia funding & Supporting People Funding
- 6 - What activities will bring about the change?** Delivering community based solutions the outlined in the PEIPII (Action Plan attached)
